Deadline to apply is May 28, 2010.

A completed entry form and the student's artwork with their name on the BACK must be in the school office by Noon on May 28. A labeled box will be provided.

After judging, 60 entries will be on display at the Great Lakes Aquarium during the months of June, July, & August, starting on June 14. Awards will be given out at an awards ceremony. Cash prizes will be awarded to the top three submissions. After being exhibited in Duluth, those 60 entries will be sent to be on display in Ohara-Isumi City, Japan.

Medium & Specifications

Only two-dimensional artwork, no larger than 11" x 17" will be accepted. Watercolor paintings only. Please do not submit framed artwork. Entries can be mounted, but not mandatory.
